German are on German oldies



About three-quarters of the classic car registered in Germany are models of German brands. Italians and the English landed on the Thursday (15.10.) Survey published by the VDA distant second to the courts.

On behalf of the Association of the Automotive Industry (VDA) has been prepared by the Federal Motor Transport Authority (KBA), while the inventory of all permanently registered passenger cars first registered before 1979 and analyzed according to manufacturers and vehicle types. The KBA determined from the 315,000 cars correspond to 0.76 percent of the total vehicle stock. How strong German classic car owners are fixated on German brands, shows the proportion of 74 percent of the authorized stock of the 30-year-old cars. Classics from the British Isles make up only a proportion of 6.2 percent and are thus exactly on a par with vintage Italian descent. The fourth-largest group are classics from France with a share of 5.2

percent, followed by American classics that come to a share of 1.9 percent.

About 165,000 vehicles with H-plates

Were traveling with an H-plate and thus characterized by its own initiative as automotive historical heritage as of 1st January 2009 a total of 164 225 cars

The most approved classics still wear an emblem of the brand Volkswagen on the bodywork. Overall, 24 percent of the KBA oldies were determined once at VW assembly line. Mercedes secures with a share of 17.2 percent ranked second in the classic car inventory. This is followed by Opel (9.9 percent), Ford (7.4 percent), Fiat / Alfa (5.5 percent), BMW (4.6 percent), Audi (3.4 percent), Porsche (2.9 percent), Trabant (2.3 percent) and Citroen (1.9 percent). The remaining 21.2 percent are distributed among many other brands.

Classic car stock is rising in Germany

Clearly evident from the figures for the KBA is that owners of older vehicles are becoming more aware of the status of their vehicles and to estimate the former as a commodity worth preserving cultural knowledge. Thus the stock of more than 30 years old, still registered cars in the past five years has increased significantly in almost all brands. Particularly striking is the development at Porsche. Porsche currently has a stock share of the total vehicle population of only 0.3 percent, driving the Porsche oldies a rich share of 2.9 per cent in the overall vintage inventory. But even with VW, Mercedes and Fiat / Alfa, the proportion in the classic car segment significantly higher than the proportion of total car ownership.

VW Beetle as favorite classics

The absolute favorite among the classics in Germany have approved models, the VW Beetle. Exactly 44 540 Wolfsburg still crawling through the streets of Germany. At a whopping 10 140 approved models, it brings the Mercedes-/8-Baureihe, the Swabians with the W123 series, the SL Series 107, Series 110/11 and the models of series 108/109 for another four placings in the top Ten retract. In between, the push is still a cadet and a record of Opel and the Eastern classic Trabant. The tenth place ranking goes to the **VW Golf** and VW so again.

The most popular are evaluated according to the VDA thus obviously the models of Volkswagen, which reached more than 76,000 vehicles accounted for just under a quarter (24 percent). But Daimler and Opel with 17 percent, 10 percent are far more popular with classic car drivers at the front. On the fourth and fifth follow Ford (seven percent) and BMW (five percent).
